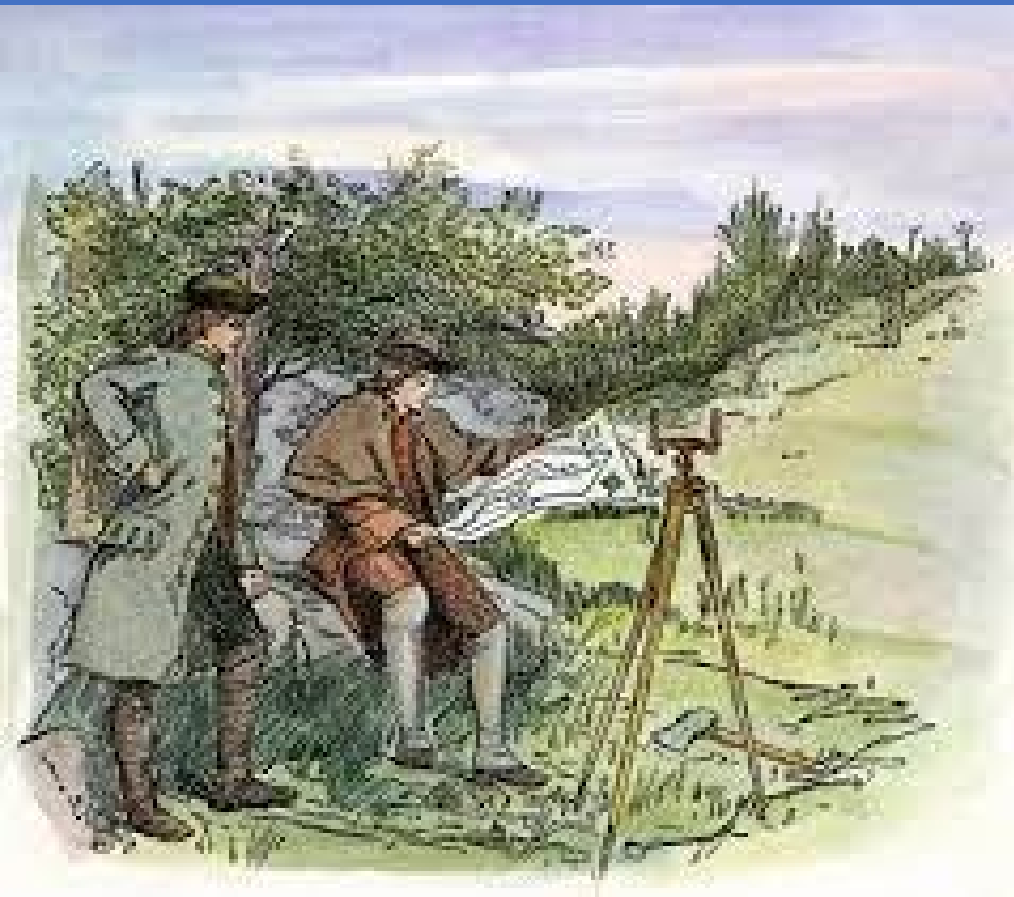

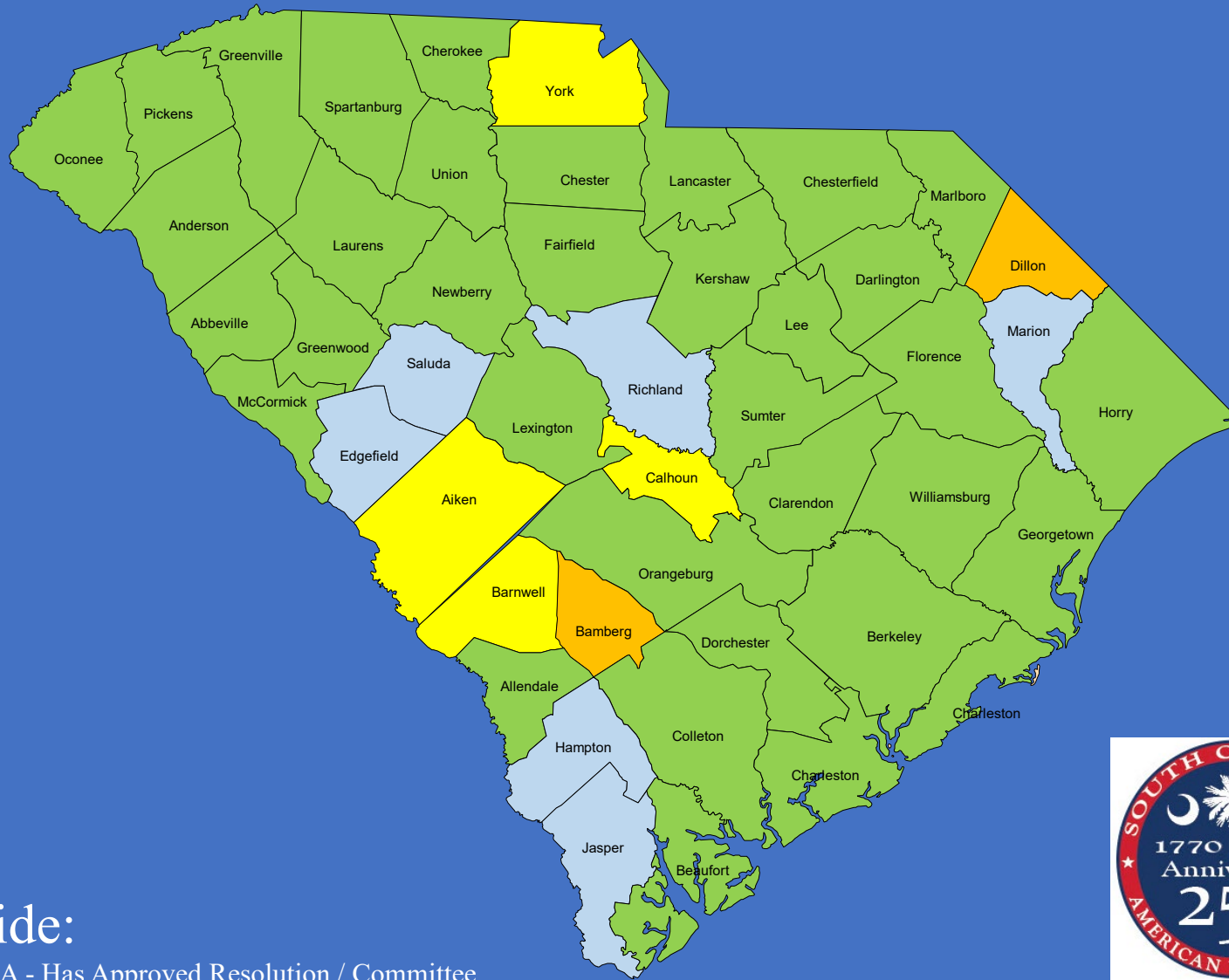

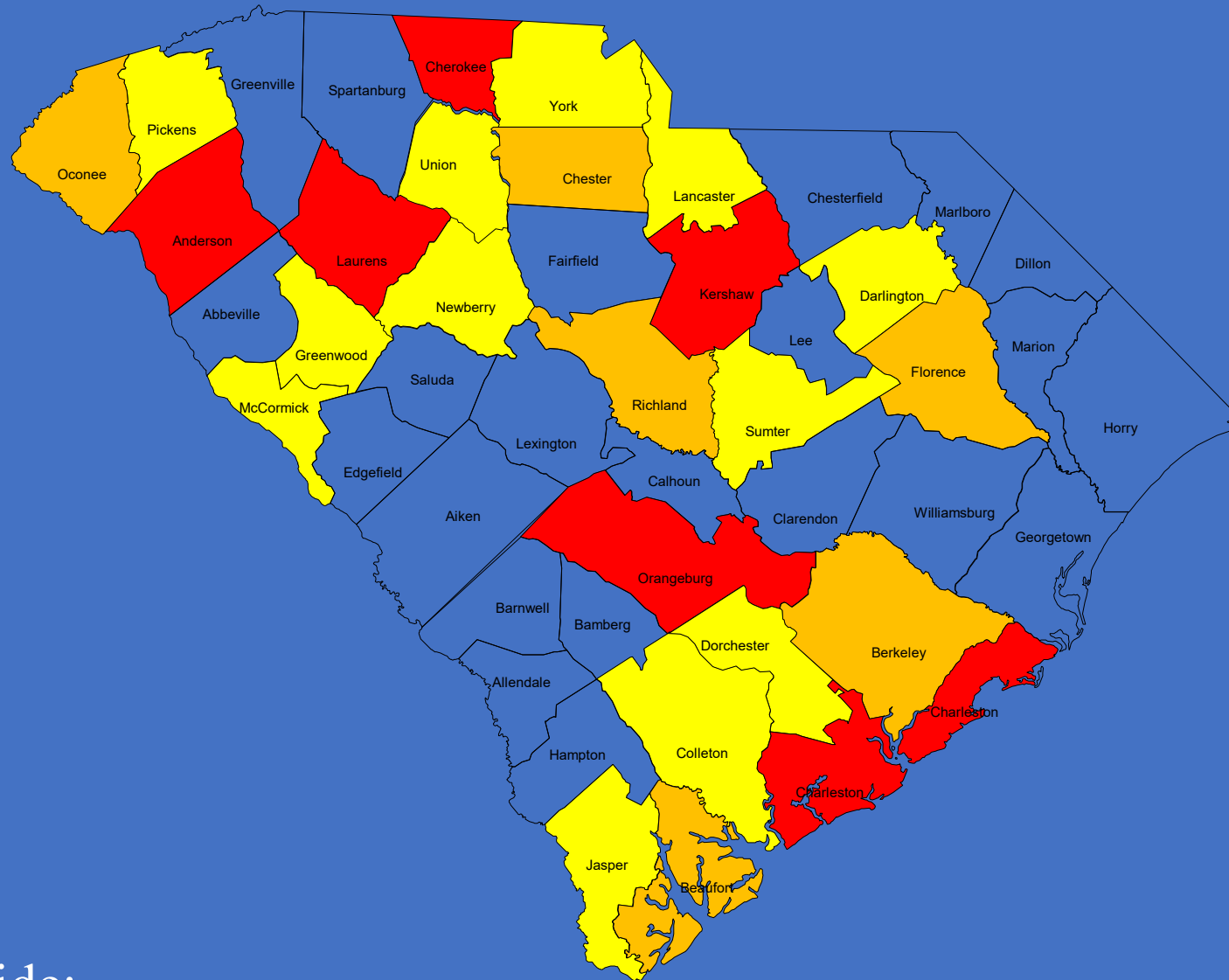

Over \$4 Million available



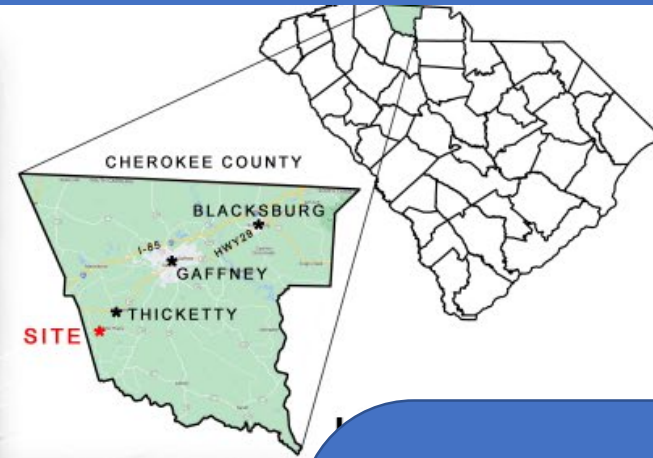

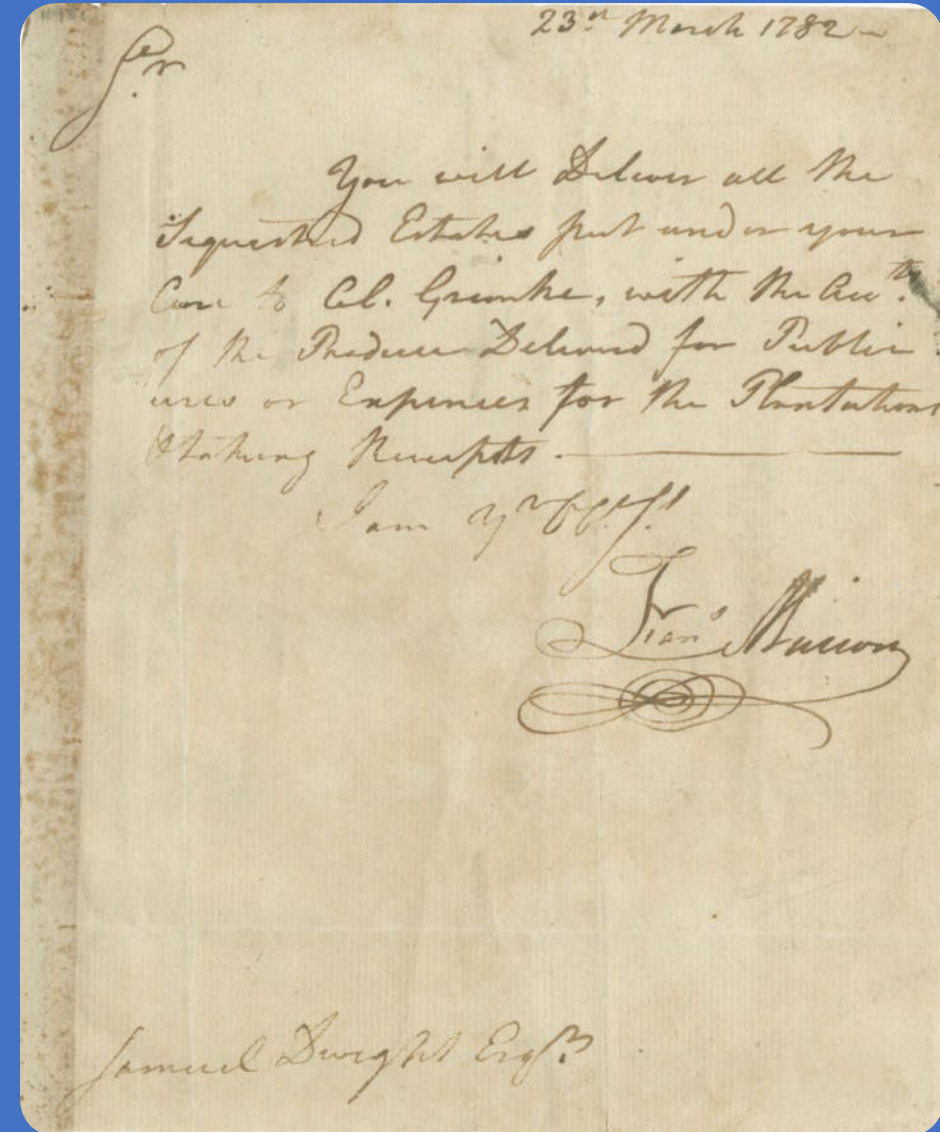
