Executors, Administrators and Assigns, to his and their only proper use and behoof forever. And I the said Charles Peters my

Executors and Administrators, the said bargained premises unto the said Andrew Lechais his

Executors, Administrators and Assigns, from and against all persons shall and will warrant and for ever defend, by these Presents. In witness whereof, I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal, Dated at Charleston this Ninth Day of September in the Year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and Seven and in the Second Year of the Independence of the United States of America.
