## RECORDS MANAGEMENT NEWS

The Records Management Division is launching a series of Virtual Town Halls for all South Carolina government agencies. This includes all state agencies, as well as governments at the local level.

Town Halls will be held once a quarter and will cover items such as new developments from the Archives, records management policies and procedures, a brief 15 minute training, and a question and answer session

The first Town Hall was held on March  $5^{\rm th}$  with County Governments. Chris Condon, the Local Records Analyst, gave a presentation on the ARM-11 form and fielded several questions about destruction procedures and retention requirements.

The second Town Hall was held March  $26^{th}$  with South Carolina Colleges and Universities. Matthew Dantzler, the Electronic Records Analyst, gave a presentation on the ARM-11 form and the SC Public Records Act, as well as fielded questions from attendees.
